Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners would concede that in purported compliance of the directions issued by this Court, a speaking order dated 14.11.2013 has been passed by the Superintending Engineer, Water Supply & Sanitation Circle, Ludhiana and in terms of which the claim of the petitioners for counting of their work charge service/ad hoc/daily wage service for grant of proficiency step-up(s), has been rejected.

In the light of such factual position, the instant contempt petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

Rule discharged.

It would, however, be open for the petitioners to raise a challenge to the order dated 14.11.2013, if, so advised and on all such grounds that may be available, strictly in accordance with law.

Disposed of.
