Representation of the petitioners has been looked into and their claim has been accepted entitling them to compensation of Rs.6,77,760/- on account of death of one Amrit Pal Singh due to electrocution. L.Rs of the deceased would thus be entitled to this compensation who are at liberty to collect the same from the respondents after complying with the necessary formalities.

In view of above, instant petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such, with liberty to the petitioners to challenge the order so passed in case they are dis-satisfied with the same.
