Short reply by way of affidavit of Virender Singh Rawat, Executive Engineer, Faridabad Water Services Division, Faridabad has been filed in the Court today and the same is taken on record.

Executive Engineer is present in Court and states that the works in question have been completed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner does not dispute that but contends that trenches which were dug over for laying pipelines remain uncovered.

Having regard to the aforesaid fact that orders of the writ Court now stand complied with substantially, instant contempt petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous but with a direction to the respondents to fill up the trenches, if any, as early as possible so as to obviate the chances of inconvenience to the people.
