The order dated 18.02.2013, the non compliance of which has been alleged by the petitioner, mandated the respondents to decide the representation within a period of three months from the date of receipt of copy of the order.

Reply filed by the respondents indicates that grievance of the petitioner has been redressed; the representation answered and the partition proceedings which were pending before the Court of competent authorities have also been decided. In these proceedings, the delay which is a cause of concern to the petitioner has also been explained.

In view of the above, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and is disposed of as such, leaving the petitioner to his remedies in law in the event of having any surviving grievances.
