The order passed by the Division Bench on 26.9.2014 is very specific in which it is mentioned that the appeal of the petitioners has to be decided by the Commissioner before 31.10.2014, failing which the petitioners would have a right to seek revival of the petition for suo-moto proceedings.

Admittedly, the petitioners have not availed the remedy which has been provided in the order itself and has rather filed contempt petition, which according to me is not maintainable. Hence, the present contempt petition is hereby dismissed.

The petitioners may, if so advised, file an application in the same writ petition for its revival for suo-moto proceedings.
