TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J.

Two separate replies i.e. one on behalf of respondent No.1 i.e. the District Development and Panchayat Officer, Patiala and the other on behalf of respondents No.3 & 4 have been filed in Court today. Same are taken on record. Copies thereof have been furnished to the counsel for the petitioner.

A conjoint reading of the replies filed in Court today would show that a detailed survey of the common land of Village Badshahpur, Tehsil Patran, District Patiala was carried out in which the petitioner himself was associated. In pursuant thereto, eviction proceedings were initiated against the persons who were found in unauthorized possession and the Collector, (Panchayat land)/DDPO, Patiala has even passed orders on 30.01.2015 for eviction of the unauthorized

possession from the common land pertaining to Village Badshahpur.

In the light of such factual position noticed herein above, this Court is satisfied that there has been substantial compliance of the directions issued by the Division Bench on 13.12.2012, while disposing of Civil Writ petition No.24703 of 2012.

The contempt petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
