The contempt petition alleging non compliance of the orders of this Court was adjourned *sine die* to await the decision of the SLP which has been preferred against the orders of this Court.

SLP stands decided now whereby the orders of the Division Bench have been set aside with the following directions:-

“ In view of the aforesaid analysis, we conclude and hold that the judgments rendered by the learned single Judge as well as by the Division Bench are unsustainable and are, accordingly, set aside. However, we clarify that if any financial benefit had been availed by the respondents, the same shall not be recovered, but their dates for grant of ACP Scale shall remain as determined by the appellants. Accordingly, the appeal is disposed of. The parties shall bear their respective costs.”

In view of the above, the contempt petition would not survive and is disposed of accordingly as directions of the Division Bench have now been substituted by the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court.
