This petition is filed against an order passed for temporary injunction under Order 39 Rules 1 & 2 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 [for short 'the CPC'] in favour of the petitioner which is allegedly violated by the defendant.

The remedy lies with the petitioner to file a petition under Order 39 Rule 2-A of the CPC as this Court does not have the jurisdiction to invoke the provisions of Sections 10 & 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.

In view thereof, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the petition in order to avail his remedy, in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
