Reply by way of short affidavit of the Secretary, Punjab School Education Board, has been filed in Court, taken on record. Copy supplied to the counsel for the petitioner.

It has been mentioned in the reply that the period, which was to be counted, has been counted and the pensionary benefits and retiral benefits have been calculated and released amounting to ₹6,03,062/-. Cheque No.191171 dated 14.08.2014 has been deposited in the pension account of the petitioner.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has not been granted the benefit of continuity of service as per the directions issued by this Court in the earlier writ petition, which was preferred by him.

If that be so, the petitioner may avail of the remedy qua that relief in accordance with law.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition is disposed

of as infructuous.
