The order dated 26.07.2012, the non compliance of which the petitioner alleges, required the State Government or the acquiring authority not to advertise any residential plot for sale without conducting an exercise in respect of plots ear-marked for reserved categories and after identification of the plots available for the oustees in each sector. It was further directed that thereafter the State Government or the acquiring authority shall publish an advertisement inviting applications from such oustees to apply for allotment of plots in accordance with law, which has since been complied with as has been stated at bar by the learned counsel appearing for the respondent, rendering the instant petition infructuous, which is disposed of accordingly, leaving the petitioner to his remedies in law in the event of his dissatisfaction against the order so passed.
