The present petition has been preferred by the petitioner
alleging non-compliance of the terms and conditions of the settlement,
which forms a part of the order dated 23.01.2013 (Annexure P-2) passed in

CWP No. 11681 of 2010 titled as Sh. Krishan Chand vs. Union of India and others.

A perusal of the reply filed by the respondents indicates that subsequently payment has been made to the petitioner. There are certain disputed questions of fact, which cannot be gone into in this contempt petition and in any case, it does not appear to be an intentional violation or non-compliance of the order passed by this Court/terms of the agreement before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of the High Court.

Liberty is, however, granted to the petitioner to avail of his alternative remedy, in accordance with law, including execution proceedings.
