The petitioner had made a grievance of non-compliance of the order passed by this Court on 22.6.2015 mandating the respondent to take action on the representation of the petitioner which had highlighted the grievance of inaction in a case pertaining to FIR No.48 dated 2.6.2015. In the present proceedings also this Court has passed an order on 3.8.2015 noticing the grievance of the petitioner.
