Learned State counsel would advert to the order dated 13.2.2014, passed by the Chief Engineer, Ranjeet Sagar Dam Project, Irrigation Works, Punjab Shahpur Kandi Township and appended as Annexure R-2 along with the reply filed on behalf of respondent no.3 and would submit that the claim of the petitioner seeking benefit under the Rehabilitation & Resettlement Policy dated 18.11.1993, has since been considered and stands rejected.

By virtue of passing of order dated 13.2.2014 (Annexure R-2) compliance of the order dated 29.9.2011 passed in CWP No.18434 of 2011 has been made.

Accordingly, the present contempt petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

Rule discharged.

It would, however, be open for the petitioner to raise a challenge to the order dated 13.2.2014 (Annexure R-2), if, so advised and on all such grounds as may be available strictly in accordance with law.
