MAHESH GROVER, J.

The order of the writ Court mandated consideration on affixation of the value of the land in a transparent and participative manner after affording an opportunity to the petitioner to adduce proof in that regard. The decision was to be taken within 30 days of the passing of the order.

Learned counsel for the respondent states that the matter has now been concluded as Hon'ble Supreme Court has determined the controversy. The allotment in favour of the petitioner has been negated. Rates too have been prescribed. A copy of the judgment has been produced and the same is taken on record.

In view of above, instant petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous, leaving the petitioner to his remedies in law in the event of his having any dis-satisfaction.
