Admittedly, the direction issued by this Court was only to decide claim setup by the petitioners in legal notice by passing a speaking order. The respondent has passed a detailed speaking order on 26.8.2014 against the petitioners.

In view thereof, there is hardly any reason for the petitioners to knock the door of this Court under Sections 10 & 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for seeking initiation of action against the respondents for willful and deliberate disobedience of the order passed by this Court. If the petitioners are aggrieved, they may avail their other remedy elsewhere to assail the validity of the order passed against them, in accordance with law.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioners prays for withdrawal of the petition in order to challenge the order passed against them, in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
