This Court entertained a writ petition on its own motion bearing CWP No.4559 of 2007 wherein the issue was of unauthorised construction on both sides of the scheduled roads in the State of Punjab and Haryana. The petition was disposed of on 9.7.2013 directing the Department of Town and Country Planning and the Forest Department of both the States to appoint a Senior Government Officer as Nodal Officer, who shall check out such illegal construction on the roadside and take action. Respondent No.1 was appointed as a Nodal Officer. He conducted a survey and started taking action against the violators. One such person, namely, Daljit Singh was served with show cause notice, who has challenged the same by way of CWP No.18256 of 2014. The said writ petition was disposed of by this Court vide its order dated 31.3.2015 on the ground that the principle of natural justice has

been violated and the matter was remanded back to the authority to pass a fresh order after affording an opportunity of hearing to the respective parties.

In view thereof, the cause shown by the petitioner of non-compliance of the order dated 9.7.2013 is not made out because the direction issued by this Court in the said order has been duly complied with insofar as the appointment of Nodal Officer is concerned and is being complied with in respect of the action being taken against the illegal construction raised by the persons on the scheduled road. Thus, at this stage, no action is required to be taken against the present respondents.

Disposed of.
