The possession of the demised premises has been handed over to the counsel for the petitioner in Court. The premises was to be vacated till 31.07.2015 but respondent over stayed by one month upto 31.08.2015.

Consequently, the contempt petition stands disposed of as having been rendered infructuous with a direction to the respondent that he shall pay an amount of Rs.60,500/-, which was the rent for the period of one month. The amount shall be given to the petitioner within a period of one week from today, failing which, the petitioner will be at liberty to revive the contempt petition. In that eventuality, the respondent will be responsible for the all costs and consequences.
