Short reply by way of affidavit of Paramjeet Singh Bhatti, Chief Engineer (North), Govt. of Punjab, Water Supply and Sanitation Department, Punjab, Patiala – respondent no.2 has been filed in the Court today and the same is taken on record. A copy thereof has been supplied to the counsel opposite.

The order dated 1.4.2015, non-compliance of which is alleged by the petitioners mandated the respondents to consider and decide the representation (attached as Annexure P-9 with the writ petition) by passing a speaking order within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of the order.

Reply indicates that needful has since been done and a speaking order admitting the claim of the petitioners has been passed.

In view of above, instant petition has been largely rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such but with a further direction to the respondents to satisfy the claim of the petitioners in terms of the acceptance thereof within a period of two months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.
