Counsel for the respondents contends that the construction was initiated by the Municipal Corporation but on receipt of the contempt notice, the same has not been proceeded with.

In the light of the above, the present contempt petition is disposed of by observing that if the process has to be re-initiated, the same can only be taken further in accordance with law as per the permission, which has been granted to them vide judgment and decree dated 30.04.1997 (Annexure P-1). If there is any construction material lying at the spot, which has been put by the Municipal Corporation, the same be also removed within a period of two weeks.
