The order dated 3.12.2012, non-compliance of which is alleged by the petitioner mandated the respondent-Management to make payment to the petitioner on account of benefit of leave encashment within three months from the date of the order alongwith interest @ 6% per annum from the date is accrued till its realization.

It is not disputed that the payments have been made and orders of the writ Court stand complied with.

In view of above, instant petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such, leaving the petitioner to his remedies in law in the event of any shortfalls in payments.
