The order dated 20.9.2013, non-compliance of which is alleged by the petitioner mandated the respondents to consider and decide the legal notice (attached as Annexure P-8 with the writ petition) strictly in accordance with law and in the light of the judgment rendered by this Court in case titled as **Lekh Raj Khara and others vs. State of Punjab and another** bearing CWP no. 2208 of 1989 by passing a speaking order within a period of 4 months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of the order.

Reply indicates that needful has since been done and a speaking order passed. It is further stated that payments have also been released to the petitioner.

In view of above, when orders of the writ Court stands complied with, instant petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such, with liberty to the petitioner to approach the respondents in case of any shortfalls in the payments. Rule against the respondents is discharged.
