TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J.

The instant contempt petition has been filed asserting willful non-compliance of the order dated 09.09.2014 passed by this Court while disposing of CRM No.M-30897 of 2014.

Suffice it to notice that the petitioners had approached this Court raising an allegation that they had filed a complaint under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 against the private respondents therein and whereupon the petitioner and his family members were being pressurized to withdraw the complaint. Criminal Miscellaneous was disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Fazilka to look into the controversy and if any action is warranted so as to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner, necessary steps be taken.

During the course of arguments today, counsel would concede that the petitioner is pursuing the complaint that had been filed

under the Negotiable Instruments Act and even summoning orders have already been issued. That apart, counsel has not been able to advert to any specific instance where from any threat to the life and liberty may be inferred.

No case for contempt is made out and the contempt petition is dismissed.
