MAHESH GROVER.J.

This petition raises a dispute question of fact. The petitioner states that even though he was appointed as a Sweeper, the work of Chowkidar is being taken from him. Even if the best case of the petitioner is taken, there would be difficulty in proceeding under the Contempt of Courts Act in view of lack of material indicating that the petitioner is being made to work as Chowkidar and not as a Sweeper. The petitioner is at liberty to raise his grievance to the Deputy Commissioner concerned or any other authority. In case the salary of the petitioner is not released, the Deputy Commissioner would be obliged to look into the matter.

Petition disposed of.
