The suit filed by the petitioner for permanent injunction was decreed on 9.6.2011 which was reversed in appeal by the First Appellate Court. However, in the Second Appeal, operation of the judgment and decree was stayed by this Court meaning thereby, the judgment and decree of the trial Court has come into operation. The petitioner thus, has a remedy to file a petition under Order 21 Rule 32 of the CPC as it is alleged that there is a violation of the decree by the respondents.

Insofar as the present petition is concerned, it is not maintainable. The petitioner may, if so advised, avail the aforesaid remedy, in accordance with law.
