In response to the contempt petition reply of the D.E.O (S.E.), S.A.S. Nagar, Mohali has been placed on record. Perusal of the same would reveal that the revised pension case of the petitioner, which was duly approved vide order dated 13.1.2014 (Annexure R-1) has been sent to the office of Accountant General, Punjab and even the bill towards enhanced amount of gratuity i.e. Rs.1820/- and as approved by the Accountant General, Punjab has since been submitted to the Treasury Office, Kharar on 17.1.2014.

In the light of such categorical stand taken on behalf of the State, this Court is satisfied that the directions issued by the Court stand substantially complied with.

The present contempt petition is, accordingly, disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
