MAHESH GROVER, J.

The order of the writ Court mandated the respondents to decide the appeal filed by the petitioner by passing a speaking order which has concededly been done.

Learned counsel for the petitioner would contend that it is a cryptic order and does not address the mandate of the writ Court.

In the considered view of this Court since a consideration has been granted the petitioner would have a remedy in law by impugning the order so passed on the ground that it is non-speaking but it may not be a ground to proceed against the respondents for having wilfully disobeyed the orders of the writ Court.

Disposed of with liberty aforesaid granted.
