Learned Counsel appearing for the petitioners would make a statement that the directions issued by the Writ Court have since been complied with and the requisite financial benefits have been released to the employees by the Principal employer i.e. the college.

Accordingly, the instant contempt petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

Rule discharged.

In the light of directions contained in the judgment dated 23.08.2011 passed by this Court, it would be obligatory for the State of Punjab to reimburse the requisite amount to the college concerned as necessary payment stands released in favour of the employees.
