This Court has been informed that on the previous date of hearing the minor was present in Court and he had refused to go with the petitioner.

In the considered opinion of this Court such directions of visitation rights in the given set of circumstances cannot be enforced considering the fact that the child himself has refused to meet the father. These are matters involving human emotions and cannot be bound by dictates of law in the eventuality of a human being capable of expressing his views and taking a stand to the contrary.

Hence, instant petition is dismissed, leaving the petitioner to his remedies in law.
