The order of the writ court directed the respondent-General Manager, Punjab Roadways, Ludhiana to pass a fresh order regarding claim of the petitioner for grant of benefit for the period 1.8.1981 to 1.2.1983 for the purpose of retiral benefits in the light of award dated 7.11.1982.

The respondents have since done the needful by passing a fresh order taking into consideration the directions of the writ court. Consequently, the amounts due to the petitioner have already been released.

Reply was filed on 27.8.2015. There is no counter affidavit by the petitioner. Consequently, the contempt petition is

disposed of as having become satisfied leaving the petitioner to his remedies in law in the event of his having any subsisting grievance against the action of the respondent.
