Main case

Pursuant to the previous orders of this Court rent equivalent to three months have been paid to the petitioner. Respondent who is present in Court has also suffered a statement that in future he will not commit any default. His statement to this effect has been recorded separately. In case any such default is committed by him in payment of rent by 7th of each month, this Court will proceed against him on the assumption that he has willfully disobeyed the orders of this Court. For the present, since the grievance of the petitioner stands satisfied, instant contempt petition is disposed of as having become infructuous, with liberty to the petitioner to revive the same in case of any violation of the undertaking given by the respondent.
