Reply to the contempt petition by way of affidavit dated 08.01.2015 of the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar along with Annexures R-1 has been filed in Court today and the same is taken on record. A complete copy of the same has been furnished to the counsel for the petitioners. Perusal of the reply would reveal that in due compliance of the order dated 03.04.2014 passed by this Court in CWP No.7005 of 2001, the benefit of ACP stands granted to each of the three petitioners and accordingly, their pay has been re-fixed and arrears already stand paid.

Such factual position is not disputed by the counsel appearing for the petitioners.

This Court finds that there has been substantial compliance of the orders passed by this Court.

Accordingly, the contempt petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

Rule discharged.

It is directed that the revised pensionary benefits on the basis of grant of ACP benefits be also released to the petitioners without any further delay.
