The order dated 20.02.2013, the non compliance of which the petitioner alleges, required the respondent no.4 i.e General Manager, Haryana Roadways Jind depot to consider the claim of the petitioners and to decide the representation dated 19.11.2012 (Annexure P8) strictly in accordance with law and by passing a speaking order within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order. It was further clarified that in case, the claim of the petitioners is found to be covered under the judgment of this Court in **Ram Swaroop and others v. The State of Haryana and others**, it shall be open to the respondents to confine the benefit of actual arrear to a period of 38 months prior to the date of filing of instant writ petition.. The order has since been complied with as has been stated at bar by the respondent, rendering the instant petition infructuous, which is disposed of accordingly, leaving the petitioner to his remedies in law in the event of his dissatisfaction against the order so passed.
