The order dated 1.4.2014, non-compliance of which is alleged by the petitioner mandated the respondents to consider the case of the petitioner in view of policy laid down for Land Losers and as per legal notice (Annexure P-9 attached with the writ petition) within a period of 2 months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of the order. It was further mandated the in case of petitioner's entitlement, the relief shall be granted to him within a period of two months thereafter.

Reply indicates that needful has since been done and a speaking order passed.

In view of above, instant petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such, with liberty to the petitioner to challenge the order so passed in case he is dis-satisfied with the same.
