Compliance report in the shape of an affidavit of Shri Om Parkash, Estate Officer-I, HUDA, Gurgaon has been filed in court indicating that the boundary walls of cremation ground have been removed as also the Malba. As such the area of the cremation ground now stands merged with the existing Janam Divas Udhyan Park. The area has been levelled and a walking/jogging track has been earmarked with work in progress in this regard. Photographs have been appended to fortify the assertions made in the affidavit.

In view of the aforesaid, I am of the opinion that the order of the writ court stands complied with rendering the instant petition infructuous which is disposed of accordingly.

In case there is any portion of the order of the writ court, which still remains uncomplied with by the respondents, the petitioner would be at liberty to bring it to their notice . The petitioner would also be at liberty to take recourse to his other remedies in law in the event of his having any further dissatisfaction against the respondents.
