AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (Oral):

Counsel for the parties agree that the order passed by this Court has been duly complied with by the passing of the promotion order of the petitioner dated 27.02.2015 (Annexure R2/1). In pursuance thereto, the Government of Punjab has also passed the order of promotion of the petitioner and the pay-scale has also been fixed alongwith fixation of seniority. The order dated 18.03.2015 (Annexure R/2) passed by this Secretary, Local Government, Punjab, indicates that no financial benefit has been given to the petitioner.

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Counsel for the petitioner prays for liberty to challenge the said order denying the financial benefits. He, however, states that the consequential benefits so far as his future retiral benefits are concerned, that should be granted to him.

For the said benefit, the petitioner may file a detailed representation claiming the said benefit which shall be considered and decided by the respondents within a period of four weeks from the date of submission of such representation.

In case, the claim of the petitioner is accepted, the consequential benefits be released to him within a period of four weeks thereafter.

Disposed of as such.
