The order of this Court dated 13.7.2011 mandated the respondents to give family pension to the petitioner w.e.f. 1.4.1997 till date along with interest @ 6% per annum within the period specified therein.

Reply and other affidavits which have been filed during the course of proceedings indicate that family pension along with interest has been paid to the petitioner. The petitioner however, would contend that she is entitled to family pension since 1971.

I am afraid, the order of the writ court does not mandate as such. Consequently, finding that the order of the writ court stands complied with, the contempt petition is dismissed leaving the petitioner to her remedies in law in case of her dissatisfaction.
