AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (Oral):

Respondent No.4, who is present in Court, states that the interest will be released to the petitioner within a period of one week. Initially as per the advise given, the interest was not paid to the petitioner but keeping in view the position which has emerged during the hearing of the case where, it is made clear that the interest has to be paid for three years prior to the date of filing of the writ petition, the said amount will be released to the petitioner within a period of one week from today.
