Learned State counsel upon instructions from Sh. Surinder Pal Singh, Senior Assistant, Punjab Dental College & Hospital, Amritsar would make a statement that the judgement dated 13.5.2013, passed by this Court in CWP No.17588 of 2000 has since been complied with. State counsel further submits that arrears of salary on account of grant of pay scale of Rs.480-880 w.e.f. the date of appointment of the petitioner as also arrears of revised leave encashment, arrears of revised death-cum-retirement gratuity, have already been released to the petitioner. It has further been stated that even the revised pensionary benefits stand released to the petitioner.

In the light of such categoric statement furnished on behalf of the State, the instant contempt petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
