Additional affidavit by Surinder Paul, Deputy Director (Grants), o/o

Director Public Instruction (Colleges) Punjab on behalf of respondents no. 1 and 2 has been filed in the Court today and the same is taken on record. A copy thereof has been supplied to the counsel opposite.

The aforesaid affidavit indicates compliance. Learned counsel for the petitioner, however, disputes the quantum to contend that amount has been calculated by treating her as Senior Most Lecturer instead of Principal.

On due consideration of the matter, I am of the view that since the orders of this Court mandated grant of selection grade w.e.f 1990 alongwith interest and the same having been paid, would render the instant petition

infructuous and the same is disposed of as such, particularly, when in the writ proceedings no such directions regarding the grant of selection grade by treating the petitioner as Principal was ever made. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to make his grievance by taking recourse to appropriate remedies in law.
