TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J.

The instant contempt petition was filed asserting willful disobedience of the judgment dated 04.07.2013 passed by the writ Court in CWP No.23731 of 2011.

Upon notice of motion having been issued, a response to the contempt petition by way of affidavit of the Chairman and Managing Director of the Punjab State Power Corporation Limited has been placed on record. Perusal thereof would reveal that LPA was preferred against the judgment rendered by the learned single Judge and the same was dismissed on 06.08.2014. Thereafter towards compliance of the directions of the writ Court, the requisite payments have already been made to the three petitioners vide cheque Nos.723283, 723284, 723285 dated 26.08.2014.

In the light of such categorical stand taken on behalf of the respondent/contemner, this Court is satisfied that the directions of this Court stand complied with.

Accordingly, the instant contempt petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
