The order dated 23.2.2012, non-compliance of which is alleged by the petitioner mandated the respondents to consider and decide the representation (attached as Annexure P-3 with the writ petition) in accordance with law.

Reply indicates that needful has since been done as representation of the petitioner has been looked into and an inquiry has been conducted whereafter representation of the petitioner has been filed as the same was found to be false.

In view of above, when orders of the writ Court stands complied with, instant petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such, with liberty to the petitioner to avail himself of this remedies in law. Rule against the respondents is discharged.
