The instant contempt petition has been filed asserting willful and deliberate non-compliance of the order dated 20.2.2013, passed by the Writ Court while disposing of CWP No.3693 of 2013.

Suffice it to notice that the claim of the petitioner as regards grant of compassionate appointment/ex-gratia assistance was to be considered by taking a final decision on the representation that had already been submitted.

In the response filed to the contempt petition, an order dated 17.5.2013 stands appended as Annexure R-2. In the light of such order a decision has been taken that the Haryana Compassionate Assistance to the Dependents of Deceased Govt. Employees Rules, 2006, issued by the State Govt. do not apply to the respondent-Sugar Mills and the claim can only be considered under the Ex-gratia Rules, 2005 which stand duly approved to the respondent-Sugar Mills. It has further been stated in the order that till date the petitioner has not submitted the requisite form to claim the benefit

of ex-gratia.

In the light of the order dated 17.5.2013 having been passed by the Managing Director of the Shahabad Cooperative Sugar Mills Ltd. Shahabad Markanda, District Kurukshetra there has been substantial compliance of the directions issued by this Court. No case for contempt is made out.

Petition is dismissed.
