Affidavit of Smt. Jagir Kaur wife of Harbhajan Singh r/o village

Ucha, P.S. Adampur, Tehsil and District Jalandhar has been filed in the Court today and the same is taken on record.

It is stated by learned counsel for the respondents that Jagir Kaur, wife of respondent no.1 is present in Court and states that she has resiled from the compromise which envisaged withdrawal of the suit before the Civil Court. The rest of the terms of the compromise stood fulfilled. The said suit was ultimately dismissed and Jagir Kaur filed an appeal against it. This indicates that she has no respect for the Court proceedings and after entering into a compromise did not discharge her responsibility. The Court in turn was persuaded to pass orders on the strength of the compromise. The pendency of the civil suit and the appeal

resulted in sheer wastage of public time which could have been utilized for

benefit of the other litigants.

Jagir Kaur has placed on record her apologies for her conduct. The Court in the peculiar circumstances of the case and noticing the fact that she is an old lady of 75 years accepts the apology tendered by her in Court but deems it appropriate to impose costs of Rs.2500/- which shall be deposited before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court within two months from today.
