In response to the contempt petition a status report by way of affidavit dated 9.1.2015 of the Director, Secondary Education, Haryana along with Annexures R-1 to R-3, has been filed in Court today and the same is taken on record. Complete copy has been furnished to learned counsel for the petitioner.

Perusal of the status report would reveal that in compliance of the order dated 6.11.2012, passed by this Court in CWP No.17861 of 2012, the claim of the petitioner has been considered and he has been found entitled to one grade increment on promotion as Head Master and order dated 18.11.2014 at Annexure R-1 has been passed to such effect. Amount of arrears of Rs.3505/- already stands paid by the Principal of the concerned school through E.C.S/R.T.G.S on 21.11.2014 (Annexure R-2). Even the revised pension case of the petitioner has been submitted by the Block Education Officer, Uchana, District Jind vide memo dated 21.11.2014 (Annexure R-3) to the Accountant General, Haryana.

In the light of such factual position, substantial compliance of the directions issued by this Court, has been duly made. Contempt petition is, accordingly, disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

Rule discharged.

It is, however, observed that the consequential financial benefits emanating from the order dated 18.11.2014 at Annexure R-1 would be released in favour of the petitioner expeditiously and in any case, within a period of eight weeks from today.

Disposed of.
