The order dated 20.2.2014, non-compliance of which is alleged by the petitioner mandated the respondents to consider and decide the legal notice (attached as Annexure P-4 with the writ petition) within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of the order. It was further mandated that in case petitioner is found entitled to the benefits, the same shall be released to him within a period of one month.

Reply indicates that needful has since been done and a speaking order passed.

In view of above, when orders of the writ Court stands complied with, instant petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such, with liberty to the petitioner to challenge the order so passed in case he is dis-satisfied with the same. Rule against the respondents is discharged.
