The petitioner alleges violation of the order of this court dated 16.9.2013 mandating the concerned authorities to conclude the acquisition proceedings expeditiously and disburse the compensation to the right holders.

The respondents state that this process has been held up on account of certain land-owners having challenged the acquisition proceedings where a status-quo order has been passed in view of which a conclusive colour could not be given to the proceedings in accordance with the mandate of this court.

In view of the above, I am of the considered view that

the contempt petition at this stage deserves to be disposed of considering the fact that the respondents are unable to abide by the mandate of this court in view of the proceedings pending before various courts. The petitioner in the eventuality of having a cause after the conclusion of proceedings initiated by various land-owners would be at liberty to approach this court in case the situation so warrants.
