Having considered the reply, which has been filed by the respondents and also taking into considerations the directions, which were issued by this Court vide order dated 12.10.2012 in ***CWP No.24394 of 2011*** contempt of which is alleged, I do not find it to be contemptuous.

challenge the order dated 05.11.2014 (Annexure A-2).
