AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASI, J. (ORAL)

Petitioners have approached this Court alleging non-compliance of the order dated 15.03.2012 (Annexure P-1) passed by this Court in CWP No. 4806 of 2013 titled as Dr. Subhash Soni and others vs. Union of India and others.

Upon notice, reply has been filed by the Senior Superintendent of Police, Pathankot, according to which, an FIR has been registered. On investigation, the real culprit, who was actually responsible for the crime, is stated to be one Sh. Arun Kumar, against whom the proceedings have been initiated as he is absconding.

As regards the action to be taken by the Post Master General, Punjab West Region, a written statement by way of affidavit has been filed, according to which, the main culprits are Arun Kumar and Usha Rani. Departmental action has been initiated against the erring officials and punishment also imposed on them. Details of the officials, who have been

found to be guilty for lapses, are mentioned in paras 1 and 2 of the reply on merits. The punishment, as imposed upon them and the orders contained therein, have also been appended along with reply.

In view of the above, this Court is of the opinion that the orders passed by this Court have been complied with.

Counsel for the petitioners prays for liberty to proceed further with the matter in accordance with law.

Permission, as prayed for, is granted.

Disposed of as infructuous.
