Learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that compliance of the judgement dated 27.5.2013, passed by this Court in CWP No.11656 of 2013 has since been made inasmuch as petitioner has been granted promotion to the post of Principal w.e.f. the date his junior was so promoted and has also been granted the benefit of A.C.P. Grade.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant contempt petition is rendered infructuous and is, accordingly, disposed of.

Rule discharged.

It is, however, directed that since the petitioner already stands superannuated in the year 2010, the admissible consequential benefits in pursuance to the grant of promotion to the post of Principal as also having been granted the A.C.P benefit would also flow in favour of the petitioner and be released to him expeditiously and in any case within a period of two months from today.

Disposed of.
