Counsel for respondent No.1 states that the costs will be deposited with the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of the High Court today itself by way of draft.

Status report has been filed in Court, taken on record. On the basis of status report, counsel for respondent No.1 states that a speaking order dated 11.05.2015 (Annexure R-1) has been passed, according to which the petitioner has been held eligible for allotment of plot under the oustees quota in view of the Policy dated 10.09.1987 subject to payment of costs of plot and interest thereon.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the allotment letter has not been issued to the petitioner, in response thereto, counsel for the respondent No.1, on instructions from Shri Ashok Kumar, Assistant, office of Estate Officer, HUDA, Karnal, states that the allotment letter will be issued to the petitioner within a period of two months from today.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous subject to the petitioner being issued the allotment letter within a period of eight weeks. Liberty is granted to the petitioner to revive the contempt petition, in case the period within which the allotment letter has to be issued, is not so done.
